

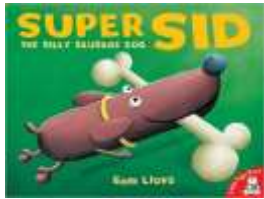

Banana Muffins

You will need:

- 2 Eggs
- 100g Self Raising Flour
- 100g Margarine
- 100g Caster Sugar
- 1 Banana

METHOD

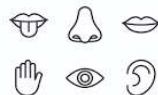
Stay safe-ask a grown up to help

1. Preheat the oven to 200 degrees Celsius/Gas mark 6.
2. Put the sugar and margarine into a bowl and whisk.
3. Add the flour, egg and mashed banana, gradually mix until smooth.
4. Divide into muffin cases and cook for 12-20 mins. Enjoy!
