

This has already started and is going very well – pupils are enjoying a delicious breakfast and fun



activities before school every day and get 'fast-tracked' to the playground every morning! No need to queue! We have some spare places which need to be booked and paid for in advance through Parent Pay so that we are able to make arrangements to support pupils in their Year group bubbles. Coats are still essential!

We are aware that current arrangements to keep the pupil bubbles and families safe and socially



distanced mean that occasionally pupils will be waiting in the rain at the start or end of the day. Unfortunately at this time we are unable to change this. With your help in moving through the school grounds quickly we are clearing the playground on average in 8 minutes. By sending your child with a warm/waterproof coat with a hood, we can help to make sure that they are kept as dry as possible whilst they wait to be collected.

Parents' Evenings

Parents' Evenings have always been a great way for you to find out how well your child is doing in their learning as well as how you can support them at home. Hopefully you have all now signed up for a phone conversation with your child's class teacher during the first week back.

Remote Learning

You may be aware that on October 22nd, the government will implement a legal duty for schools to provide remote learning for pupils who are absent from school due to self-isolation or if their bubble has closed due to a positive case. We are developing our policy in response to this and it will be shared with you after half term. There will be a range of teaching and learning available using online platforms as well as some recorded lessons for your child to engage with if they are self-isolating. The government expectation is for pupils to access this to ensure they do not fall behind with their learning.


