Didn't couldn't


Reading: the children will learn these reading skills:

Topic Title: Carnival of The Animals
Music and Art theme.

Hook for Learning:
Launch: Music- Carnival of the animals.
Land: Perform music they have composed about each animal.
Share animal artwork and dances.



Main subject:
Artist theme week

The children will research and learn about the artist Henri Matisse during artist theme week. Look at where he lived (French artist) look at his most famous work and styles eg The Snail.

Listen to and appreciate music by Camille Saint Saens.
Visit Tropical Birdland.
