LO: To invent and describe an alien using noun phrases

From The Jamie Drake Equation...

“Imagine the planets we might discover orbiting Tau Ceti. What strange alien creatures could they find there? I want you to invent your own alien species. Think about the kind of world that it’s from. Does this have jungles or deserts, or might it be some kind of water world? How will this affect the type of alien you invent? Will it need tentacles instead of arms and legs like you and me? Maybe it could fly like a bird through clouds of ice and dust? Maybe it will swim? What will it eat, and how?”

Design an Alien,

- Draw and label it
- Write a descriptive paragraph about the alien.

Remember to use descriptive language and noun phrases, similes and metaphors.

Avoid: “The alien was big.”

Instead try: “Despite living on a miniature planet, the alien was incredibly large with several long flexible limbs, which enabled the alien to grip the planet and not fall off.”
