Mini Mash tasks:

30th March 2020:

Parents, you will need to do this with your child until they are familiar with Mini Mash.

Go into the Numbers & Counting section of Mini Mash.

Scroll through the tasks and select 'Maths City', then click on the playground picture.

Watch the videos and complete the counting tasks (instructions are given):

- Water the plants and watch them grow
- Set up an outdoor area and count the objects
- Play the flower 'matching pairs' game
- Move the children to the various activities and select a number of actions for them to complete.

Select '2Count' in the Numbers and Counting section.

Choose a topic e.g hair colour / hair colour / favourite foods of your family and friends and make a chart. Which one is the most popular / least popular?

Save your chart into your tray.

31st March 2020:

Go into the Games section of Mini Mash.

Choose two more puzzles from each level to complete. Save them into your tray.

Go to the 'Role Play' section (go to the door and go outside).

Choose a character from the selection. Can you take a photo of yourself using the camera icon ,to become that character? Type your name into the box next to the character and save the character to your tray. Choose a different character and repeat.

1st April 2020:

Go to the 'Music and Sounds' section (outside), and select '2Explore'.

Create some tunes using the different chime sounds. Record your tunes and play them back. Use the speed slider to make the tunes faster or slower. How many different tunes can you create?

Go into your tray & find the jigsaw puzzles saved in there – train & castle. Can you complete the puzzles and re-save them into your tray?

2nd April 2020:

Go to the 'Drawing & Painting' section (pictures hanging from the ceiling)

Select the birthday cake picture & colour it in. How many candles will you add to your cake? Count the candles and type the number at the bottom of the picture. Type your name and save the pictue into your drawer.

Go to the 'Numbers and Counting' section and select 'Maths City'. Select the farm area & do the matching pairs, pattern and counting activities & watch the video about a farm.

Can you create your own farm using your toys at home?

3rd April 2020:

Go outside & visit the 'Drawing & Painting' section.

Select '2Paint a Picture' and choose a paint style. Draw or paint a picture & save it into your drawer.
