

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory - Task 4 - Getting lost!

Describe what they could see and what might happen to them.

Remember to use the following: -

- Conjunctions to extend sentences (and, but, because, so, with, if, when)
- Sentence openers (After a while, the next moment, in the distance, later that day)
- Expanded noun phrases (Thick chocolate, with blobs of sticky marshmallows, came oozy out of the machine completely covering her from head to toe)
- Similes (as quick as a flash, as fast as a rocket)
- Commas
- Exclamation marks
- Prepositions (in between, next to, behind, above, below)
